Tenders are hereby invited from suitable service providers for the supply of road signs with road sign bolts and nuts; bolts, nuts and washers for road signs; bolts and nuts for grader and guardrail sheets and poles for the period ending 30 June 2025.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: This tender is subject to Regulation 8 “Local Production and Content” of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000: Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 (No. R.32 dated 20 January 2017). Submitting of the MBD 6.2 and applicable annexures are compulsory. Bidders must achieve the minimum local content for:

- Steel Products and Components for Construction **(100% Local Content)**

The sealed envelopes **must** be placed in the tender box at the Municipal Offices situated at **26 Long Street, Bredasdorp, 7280** not later than **12:00 on Friday, 26 August 2022**. Tenders will be opened in public thereafter.

Tenders submitted by fax, e-mail, or received after the closing time and date shall not be accepted. Tenders may only be submitted on the prescribed official document.

Overberg District Municipality shall apply its Municipal Supply Chain Management Policy as adopted in terms of section 111 of the Local Government Municipal Finance Management Act, 2003 (Act No 56 of 2003) and the relevant regulations. Tenders will be evaluated according to the criteria and weight of the 80/20 preferential procurement system. Bidders must submit a valid Tax Compliance status PIN, issued by the South African Revenue Services.

It is the prerogative of the municipality not to accept the lowest, a part of or any tender at all.
